

Step 1 of 7 Your Hearing Aid Model


Beltone Rely 63 RIE

Your new hearing aid uses replaceable batteries

 RIE stands for receiver-in-ear, which refers to the speaker that produces the sound that is in the ear canal


63 is your model number

Located at the top of hearing aid body,



Activate Streaming Upon activating streaming, you'll hear a short melody, after which you can stream sound from a TV streamer, extra microphone or other accessory.



button specifically to you, the instructions below might not apply to you.

A short click up or down will increase or decrease the volume. You will hear a single beep with each click.

Adjust Volume

Step 4 of 7

Programs are simply settings on your hearing aids that optimize your hearing experience in specific situation like dining out or taking a walk outdoors. Press and hold up for 1 second to switch to the next program.

Example: 1 beep indicates program 1, 2 beeps indicates program 2, etc. Activate Streaming

Press and hold down for 3 seconds to activate streaming to accessories.

Example: If you have a TV streamer or extra microphone, press and hold down for 3 seconds to activate.



The All-Around program is designed to give you optimal sound amplification across the many different situations you encounter throughout your day. Situation: Your day-to-day routine. This program is activated by default when you turn on your hearing aids.

The Music program helps to optimize your listening experience by enhancing the details of the lower, middle, and higher notes. Situation: Listening to any form of recorded or music, as well as singing or performing music yourself. Move on to Step 6
